

NO-COST MAMMOGRAMS & PAP TESTS FOR LOUISIANA WOMEN WHO QUALIFY

Can I get no-cost cancer screenings and navigation support?

Yes - if you meet the following criteria:

1. Age:

- Cervical cancer screening (Pap test): 21 to 64.
- Breast cancer screening (mammogram): 40 to 64.
- You can also get help if you're younger than 40 and are having symptoms.
- 2. **Income**: Your household income must be at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level. See chart to the right for more information.

3. Insurance Status:

- Uninsured You can get screenings and navigation support.
