Cancer is a leading cause of death in women. Regular mammograms and Pap-tests can help find breast and cervical cancer early when it's easier to treat.

## What kind of help can I get through LBCHP?

#### Clinical Services:

- Clinical breast exam
- Mammogram
- Pelvic exam\*
- Pap test\*
- Diagnostic tests

### **Navigation Services:**

- Support
- Help making appointments
- Help getting to your appointments
- Connecting you to translation services
- · Making sure you get treated after cancer is found

## Can I get no-cost cancer screenings and navigation support?

Yes - if you are a Louisiana resident, and you meet the following criteria:

#### **1.** Age:

- Cervical cancer screening (Pap test): 21 to 64.
- Breast cancer screening (mammogram): 40 to 64.
- You can also get help if you're younger than 40 and are having symptoms.
- 2. Income: Your household income must be at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level.

#### 3. Insurance Status:

- Uninsured You can get screenings and navigation support.
- Insured You can get navigation support. If a needed diagnostic service is not covered by your insurance or you can't afford your co-pay/deductible, LBCHP can help.
